Dr. Daniel McQuillen graduated from the Medical School of Wisconsin, completed Infectious Disease Fellowship training at The Maxwell Finland Laboratory for Infectious Diseases at Boston University School of Medicine and is Board Certified in Infectious Disease and Internal Medicine. He is immediate Past-President of the Massachusetts Infectious Disease Society and is a member of the Infectious Diseases Society of America's Board of Directors. Dr. McQuillen directs the Transplant Infectious Diseases service at LHMC and also cares for patients living with HIV, with interests in outpatient IV antimicrobial therapy, general infectious diesases, hospital acquired infectious and tick-associated infections.

Dr. McQuillen will speak about currently prevalent arthropodborne diseases in Massachusetts, with a focus on Powassan virus and other tick-associated diseases, using illustrative cases to highlight clinical presentation, diagnosis and treatment.
